



Company Fact Sheet

Founded in 1895, in Faribault, Minn, the Faribault Foods company has evolved from a seasonal vegetable canning company into an industry leader in a wide range of canned and pouched food products. In August 2014, Faribault Foods was acquired by La Costeña Group and merged with Tucson-based Arizona Canning Company. Arizona Canning Company was founded in 2006, and produces refried beans, whole beans and enchilada sauce products. The combined US-based company is headquartered in Minneapolis, Minn.

Faribault Foods remains a privately held company employing approximately 680 people, with about 530 based in Minnesota facilities, and about 150 located at its facility in Tucson.

Faribault Foods has a strong reputation as a trusted supplier of branded, store brand and co-manufactured products. Branded products include S&W® Beans, Sun Vista®, Luck's®, Kuner's®, Mrs. Grimes®, Butter Kernel®, Chilli Man®, Pride and Pasta Select®. The company also has a strong store brand business in canned beans, pasta and meals in addition to long-standing contract manufacturing partnerships with top branded companies.

In 2017, Faribault Foods opened a new state-of-the-art manufacturing facility in Faribault, Minn. The new manufacturing facility combined three previously separate Faribault facilities into one operation, including can manufacturing, canning, labeling, storage and distribution.
